What... We wrap up the performance season with a sparkling evening of dinner, cash bar, entertainment, silent auction, raffle and more!

Who... Members, friends and fans attend this festive annual event by reservation only. Backed by a rhythm section, singers perform two choral sets, plus a cabaret segment of solos and combos. An emcee introduces our music, tosses out trivia questions, and amps up the momentum for our silent auction and raffle.



All Chorale members are expected to participate! How? By singing, attending as a guest, bringing guests, and/or contributing to our Silent Auction and Raffle.

 When & where... The Spring Gala is held in May at the Springside Inn, 6141 West Lake Road, Auburn. This year's Gala is on Sunday, May 19 at 5:00 pm. Save the date, and plan your table now!

- Why... Our annual fundraiser benefits the entire Chorale, helping us purchase music and hire instrumentalists for the following season. And... it's FUN!
- Theme... For the 2024 Gala, our music and décor will celebrate celestial objects the sun, moon, stars and planets. Bring your glow!
- Musical styles... Show tunes, pop, jazz, folk, barbershop, ballads, anthems catchy favorites that will keep the audience smiling, swaying along and humming their way home. Cabaret auditions TBA!
- Attire... "Gala" equals dress up! Gentlemen: suit or tuxedo, straight tie or bow tie. Ladies: evening or cocktail wear (long gowns, sequins, bling welcome). Choices that reflect the theme are encouraged think midnight blue, sunset rose, starry silver, sunny gold the sky's the limit!
- Reservations & cost... Katie Moran will begin taking reservations in March. Please reserve exactly the number of seats you need. Katie will assign tables she's good at matchmaking!
 - Tell Katie who in your group will be participating as singers.
 - Let Katie know of other attendees you'd like to be seated with, if possible. (Sorry, no requests for people you don't wish to sit with!)
 - Cost for guests and non-singing Chorale members: \$75. Includes hors d'oeuvres, dinner, dessert, glass of wine or soda, and donation to Chorale. (Tax deduction letter available on request.)
 - Cost for participating singers: payment for dinner only; cost TBA closer to event. (No tax deduction.)
 - All reservations are due, with payment, by Tuesday, May 7.
 - Every arriving guest must have a prepaid reservation. NO exceptions at the event.

✤ Silent Auction & Raffle

- This is so important. *Two-thirds of our Gala proceeds in 2023 came from our Silent Auction and Raffle*! Members were energized to bring in wonderful donations. Attendees were excited to bid, buy raffle tickets, and take home their winnings!
- This year, we're counting you again to ask your favorite merchants and service providers for donations, and/or bring in your own. Here's what we need:
- **Raffle items**: Gift cards, gift certificates, small items valued up to around \$25. Please contribute! We will have a box for raffle items at each rehearsal.
 - **How it works:** Gala attendees buy raffle tickets and drop them in paper bags designated for the various raffle items. A winning ticket drawn from each bag will be announced at the end of the evening, and the winners receives their raffle prizes.
- **Silent Auction:** This is for more valuable single items, gift baskets, "experiences" (theatre tickets, weekend getaway, dog grooming, salon visit, yoga series), etc. Themed baskets are encouraged, e.g., "Wine Tour in a Basket" or "Discover Pickleball!"
 - **How it works:** Gala attendees write in successive bids on bid sheets corresponding to the displayed items, either by name or by anonymous code number. After a "final bids now" announcement near the close of the evening, bids end. Each item goes to the highest bidder, who pays the bid amount to receive the item.
 - **Buy Now option:** During the Gala, an attendee can choose to pay the full posted value of an item; it is then removed from the display.
- Avoiding mix-ups:
 - Claim dibs on the vendors you'll contact! Check the sign-up sheet at rehearsal for the businesses you plan to ask for donations, so that we don't duplicate our requests. Write in your planned contacts – first come, first dibs.
 - **Log the description, value and donor** of your Silent Auction and Raffle item(s), using the form provided by the Gala Committee. **Donation** <u>forms</u> are due by Tuesday, April 23.



• Raffle and Silent Auction <u>items</u> are due by Tuesday, May 7.
